## Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

## Why palm?

Palm leaves were a symbol of grace and victory. They were laid down in front of Jesus as a mark of respect. We wave palms today to hail Christ in His triumph for our salvation in the light of His Paschal Mystery – His Passion, Death and Resurrection.

#### **Christ Comes in Peace**

The donkey symbolises His peaceful coming; He is coming to seek and to save the lost.

"Joyful acclamations at Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem, followed by his humiliation. Festive cries followed by brutal torture. This twofold mystery accompanies our entrance into Holy Week each year, as reflected in the two characteristic moments of today's celebration: the initial procession with palm branches and the solemn reading of the Passion." – Pope Francis
