MAKING THE '5 SYSTEMS' ALIVE IN OUR PARISH

The '5 systems' of a fruitful parish (discipleship, evangelisation, worship, service and fellowship) invite us all into realising God's dream Holy Family parish.

Who is responsible for growing our parish community in these areas? If we say the parish priest is responsible, then we place an unreasonable burden on him. If we say the parish pastoral council (or any other group), then we restrict our ability to grow in Jesus to a small group of people. If we say everyone is generally responsible, then we will be a community with desire but no direction.

Tim Glemkowski's Made for Mission shares a clear pathway to follow so that we can experience fruitfulness in each of the five areas.

The first step is to cast a vision of how we aspire to make God's discipleship dream our first and foremost concern. As this vision is communicated, understood and accepted by all it will inspire the necessary areas of growth needed to make discipleship more visible in our parish. A vision is then brought to life by prioritising clear pathways to intentional discipleship for all in the community, empowering them to discern their God-given charisms. As these and other leaders are empowered and mobilised, the work of aligning everything we do towards the vision can begin.
