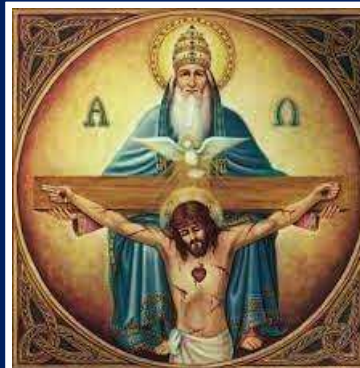

Blessings and greetings of Trinity Sunday. Great moments of celebrating the Holy Trinity is the Holy Eucharist. Holy Eucharist is an invitation to participate in the profound mystery of the inner life of the Holy Trinity. Eucharist is a Trinitarian Act: Every celebration of the Eucharist involves all three Persons of the Holy Trinity:

God the Father is the Source and Goal of the Eucharist. The Eucharist is offered to the Father, the origin of all blessings.

God the Son is the Sacrifice and the Presence. Jesus is the Priest and the Victim. In the Eucharist he becomes truly present, His Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. The Holy Mass makes present the one eternal sacrifice of Christ on the Cross.

God the Holy Spirit is the Sanctifier. Holy Ghost consecrates the bread and wine through the priest's prayer, epiclesis. The Spirit also unites the Church to Christ and makes her one body with Him.

Some of the prayers in the Holy Eucharist are beautiful expressions of revelation of Trinity.

Opening sign of the Cross – in the name of Father, Son and Holy Spirit

Gloria and Creed – Trinitarian in Form

Eucharistic Prayer – Addressed to the Father, through the Son, in the Holy Spirit

Doxology – (“Through Him and with Him and in Him...”) A final Trinitarian praise.

Final Blessing – May almighty God bless you the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

Holy Communion in the Holy Eucharist is not just with Christ but through him with the Holy Trinity. Through receiving Christ's Body and Blood, we are drawn into the divine life, a share in the Trinitarian communion of love.

"Truly, truly, I say to you, it was not Moses who gave you the bread from heaven; my Father gives you the true bread from heaven." (John 6:35)

"He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me, and I in him." (John 6:56).

"For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we are Jews or Gentiles, whether we are bond or free, and have been all made to drink into one Spirit." (1 Cor 12:13)

Holy Trinity is communion of Love. The Eucharist is the Sacrament of Love, Christ's total gift of himself. To receive the Eucharist is to be drawn into that eternal exchange of love between the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.
