

The Most Holy BODY and BLOOD of CHRIST 22nd June 2025



BLESSINGS TO YOU ALL ON THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST

'Corpus Christi' is the Latin phrase for 'The Body of Christ.' This is a general term used for the Solemnity we celebrate today. In English this Solemnity is titled as "The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ". In fact, today we are celebrating the Solemnity of the Real Presence of Jesus Christ, our Saviour in the Holy Eucharist. When understood deeply, though it is said Body and Blood, what we have in the Eucharist is the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. "In the most blessed sacrament of the Eucharist 'the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ, and therefore, the whole Christ is truly, really, and substantially contained." (CCC 1374).

Two Species, One Christ: "Since Christ is sacramentally present under each of the species, communion under the species of bread alone makes it possible to receive all the fruit of Eucharistic grace." - CCC 1390

Why Soul and Divinity along with Body and Blood?

Body refers to **Christ's physical body**—the same body that was born of the Virgin Mary, crucified on the cross, and rose from the dead. In the Eucharist, the consecrated bread is not just a symbol but becomes His true body.

Blood signifies the **actual blood of Christ** that was shed on the cross for the forgiveness of sins. The consecrated wine becomes His true blood. This reflects Jesus' words at the Last Supper: "This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins." (Matthew 26:28)

Soul refers to the **human soul** of Christ, which, like all humans, He possessed. The soul makes His presence complete as a living person—Christ was fully human as well as fully divine.

Divinity refers to **Christ's divine nature** as the Second Person of the Holy Trinity. In the Eucharist, Christ is present not only as a man but also as **God**—eternally begotten of the Father.

Presence Endures and Is Whole in Each Part:

"The Eucharistic presence of Christ begins at the moment of the consecration and endures as long as the Eucharistic species subsist. Christ is present whole and entire in each of the species and whole and entire in each of their parts, in such a way that the breaking of the bread does not divide Christ." - CCC 1390
