

Carry Peace of Christ with you as you travel, as you meet, and as you depart. Let the beginning, the journey and the end be with peace of Christ. In the Eucharistic celebration after Our Father and Deliverance prayer we wish peace to each other. "The peace of the Lord be with you, let us offer each other a sign of peace". It is a call to share the peace of Christ with everyone around us. Peace with God and with others is the trait of a Christian.

Old Testament - Shalom (Hebrew)

- Wholeness or completeness (having everything one needs to flourinsh
- Harmony in relationships between people, nations, and with creation
- Justice and well being

New Testament - Eirēnē (Greek)

- Shalom (peace) that Jesus brings
- Shalom closely connected to reconciliation between humanity and God through Christ's death and resurrection
- A Gift of the Holy Spirit and a Mark of Christian life.

Jesus sends his disciples to preach good news of the Kingdom of God. According to St. Paul, the Kingdom of God is not food or drink, it is righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. (Rom 14:17). Peace needs to be understood as a mark of God's reign.

Another direction of understanding peace is relational.

Peace with God: through the cross, Jesus reconciles sinners to God. "Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." (Rom 5:1)

Inner Peace: a deep sense of clam and trust in God, even in suffering. "The peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (Phil 4:7)

Peace with others: Christians are called to be peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God. "If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all." (Rom 12:18)

Jesus as the source of Peace: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you." (Jn 14:27). "For He Himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in His flesh dividing the wall of hostility..."

Peace is:

- 1. **Relational** rooted in right relationship with God, others, and self.
- 2. **Redemptive** made possible through the saving work of Jesus.
- 3. **Transformative** shaping communities into places of justice and love
- 4. Spiritual a fruit of the Holy Spirit (Gal 5:22)


