The Gospel today revolves around three main themes as we have it in the title, Trust, Readiness, and Faithfulness. And Jesus is instructing his disciples from a formative point of view. Guiding them into a true discipleship. These three demands of discipleship are symbolized in the following words of the passage.

Trust: "no need to be afraid" (v 32)

**Ever-Ready: Girded and Lamps lit (35)** 

Faithful: "their Master" ( v 36)

It is a self-reflection of Jesus' relationship with his Father. Trust, Readiness and faithfulness is really tested not in difficult times. He was never afraid, always ready, and faithful to the father to the death on the cross. There are many occasions we can find from the New Testament. But the most solemn of them are the moments from the Last Supper to the Death on the Cross. "And going a little farther he [Jesus] fell on his face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will," (Mt. 26/39). Along with this we can read what St. Paul teaches, "And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the

death, even death on a cross." (Philippians 2/8). The culmination of all that is, "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit" (Lk 23/46).

One important call like a 'command' to his disciples is, "See that you are dressed for action and have your lamps lit." This phrase is extracted from the cultural background of Jesus, 'gird your loins'. The way they would dress tell the world what they are up to.



Lamps lit: It is a call for being ready 'no matter what time', even in the night you are ready. Always ready for the Master

One more thing interesting about this passage is "Happy those servants whom the master finds awake when he comes. I tell you solemnly, he will put on an apron, sit them down at table and wait on them." This is a very unusual master serving servants. Jesus reveals himself as the 'Servant'. Very well connected with this is the Isaiah's prophecy of the Suffering Servant, jesus proclaiming "I have come to serve and not to be served", Jesus' extraordinary act of washing the feet of the apostles at the last supper. The servant here is the embodiment of divine humility. "Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a SERVANT, being born in the likeness of men." (Philippians 2/5-7).


