hope and understanding that God is almighty, all powerful, meaning he can do anything. This knowledge leads me to trust that He will do it. Remember when Jesus speaks of the mustard seed, and they can command the tree to move "and it would obey you." Yes, it will happen.

The obedience of the servant: as the icing on the cake for the passage today, Jesus says the parable of the servant who is keen to fulfill the needs of the master. This teaching gives us the understanding as obedience is the key to the growth in faith. The servant in the teaching is one who does the demands of the master forgetting all his needs even for the need for rest (takes care of the needs of the master even after hard work in the field).

Jesus life on earth teaches us about his unconditional obedience: "not my will but thy will be done." May be very close to this understanding is, "My food is to do the will of the Father." (John 4:34)

Mother Mary teaches that to us: "Behold the handmaid of the Lord, be it done unto me according to your word."

**Today**: the obedience today in practice would mean carrying out the instructions for a strong spiritual life laid out through the Holy Catholic Church. Concretely the Sunday Eucharistic Celebration, reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, reading of the Holy Scripture, daily prayers etc.

"Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. For by it the men of old received divine approval" (Hebrews 11: 1 - 2)
